Competition Note!!!!

It is important to remember that the Unlimited record for the BBORR is over 172 MPH!

The BBORR is more of a technical driver's challenge than a straight road course like the Nevada races. There are 59 turns in the last 50 miles leading to Sanderson. They are composed of many elevation changes and are made up of all the types of turns to be found on any road course, anywhere. These turns make it a real challenge to meet your average class speed - in any Division. Please keep this in mind when you decide on your entry Division and Class.

Refunds and Transfers

A	Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.
B	All cancellations and requests for transfer must be made in writing or email to: Big Bend Open Road Race, BBORR, 1000 Railroad Ave., Fort Stockton, Texas 79735, or by email edc@fortstockton.org or, (432) 336-2264.
C	<p>Entries canceled at least 30 days prior to the event are eligible for a refund or complete transfer.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Entries will be refunded minus the membership fees and a 10% handling fee. B. All fees (except membership fees) may be transferred towards the entry fee of a future event. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Only one transfer of fees is allowed and transfer must be used by next event.
D	Entries canceled at least 14 days prior to the event are eligible for a transfer of 50% of their paid entry fees (see Transfer Information above).

E	No transfer or refund option is available to entries canceled within 10 days of the event. A. All fees (except un-expired membership fees) will be forfeited for entries canceled within 10 days of the event. B. Event 'no-shows' forfeit all fees (except any un-expired membership fees).
F	Any changes to an entry that would result in a fee reduction (changing an entry from the Grand Touring Division down to the Touring Division) will be subject to the refund/transfer policies as mentioned above. Any such changes that are made at the event will be made without any refund or transfer of such fees.

IMPORTANT: By signing the entry application and thereby entering the event, you are certifying your understanding and acceptance of these terms. It is imperative that if you do not understand one or any of the above stated policies and/or need clarification, that you contact Big Bend Open Road Race.

BBORR will make every effort to insure that the Event will be started and completed in a timely manner. There may be occasions where Acts of God or Government Intervention may prevent the start and/or completion of the Event. If such an occasion were to arise, BBORR cannot issue refunds or rain checks.

Please note that West Texas has experienced a severe drought. Long range forecasting does not anticipate an end to the drought until October of 2012. At this time it is not anticipated that this will have an impact on the race.
